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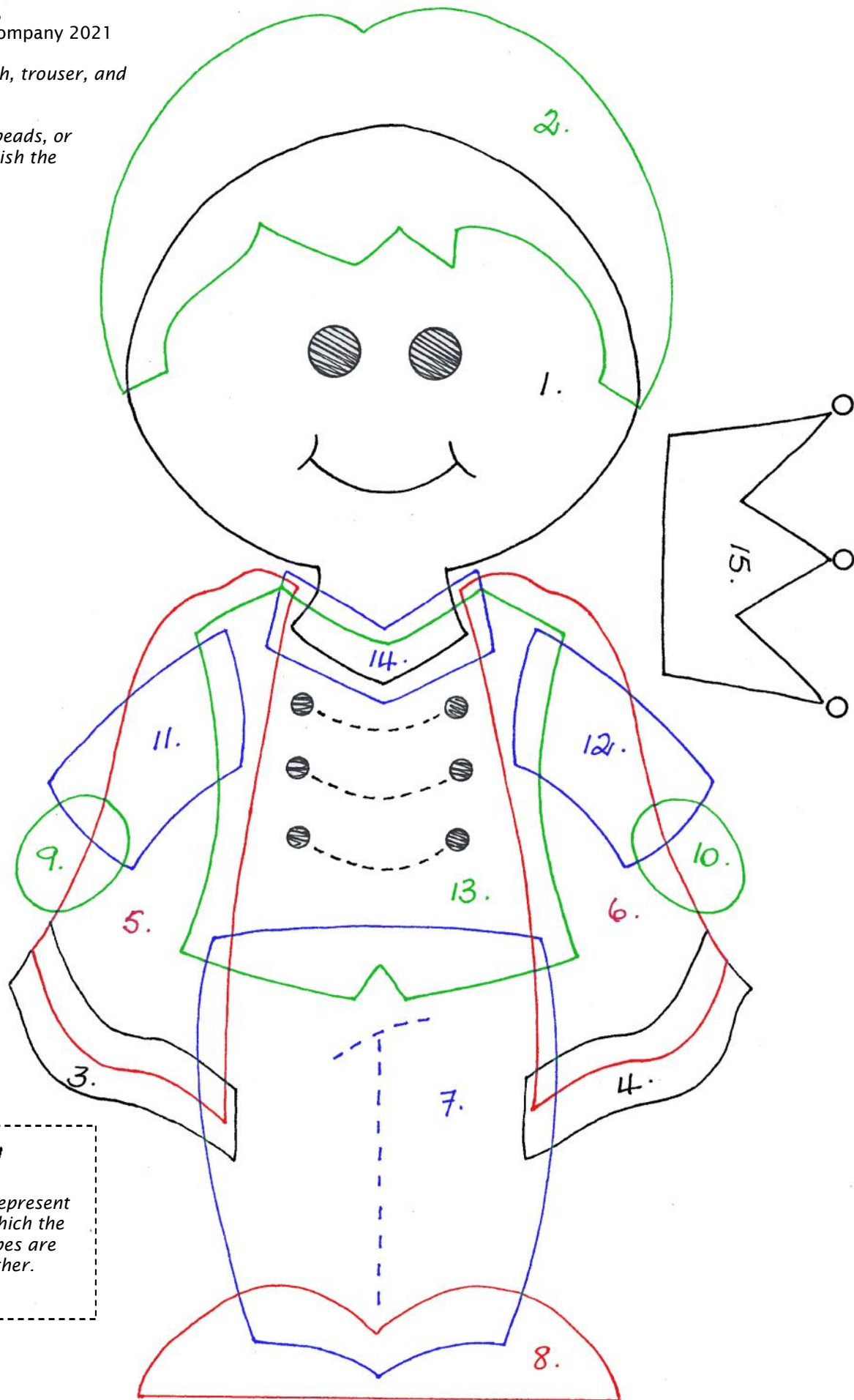

FAIRYTALE SEW-ALONG—BLOCK #5

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• Backstitch the mouth, trouser, and waistcoat details.

• Use small buttons, beads, or embroidery to embellish the waistcoat and crown.

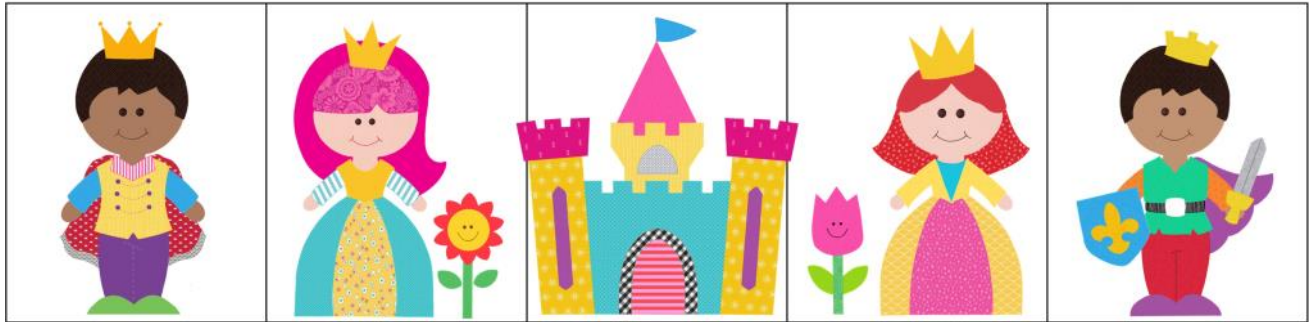


Notes!
The numbers represent the order in which the appliqué shapes are fused together.

Notes!

1. Use Diagram 1 as a guide to pin and then sew Block 2 and 5 to the blocks joined together in the last instalment. Press the seams open—this allows any overlapping applique to sit as flat as possible. Set aside.

Further Notes!

- ★ I have trimmed my blocks from the original 10 1/2in x 12 1/2in to measure 10 1/2in x 11 1/2in. I added the extra inch to the height of the original blocks to allow for applique shrinkage.
My background fabric isn't shrinking at all this time around, it's a very tight weave, therefore I have extra fabric at the top of the blocks.
I leave this decision up to you, it won't make a difference to the finished quilt except for a few inches in length. Message me if you are unsure!

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
