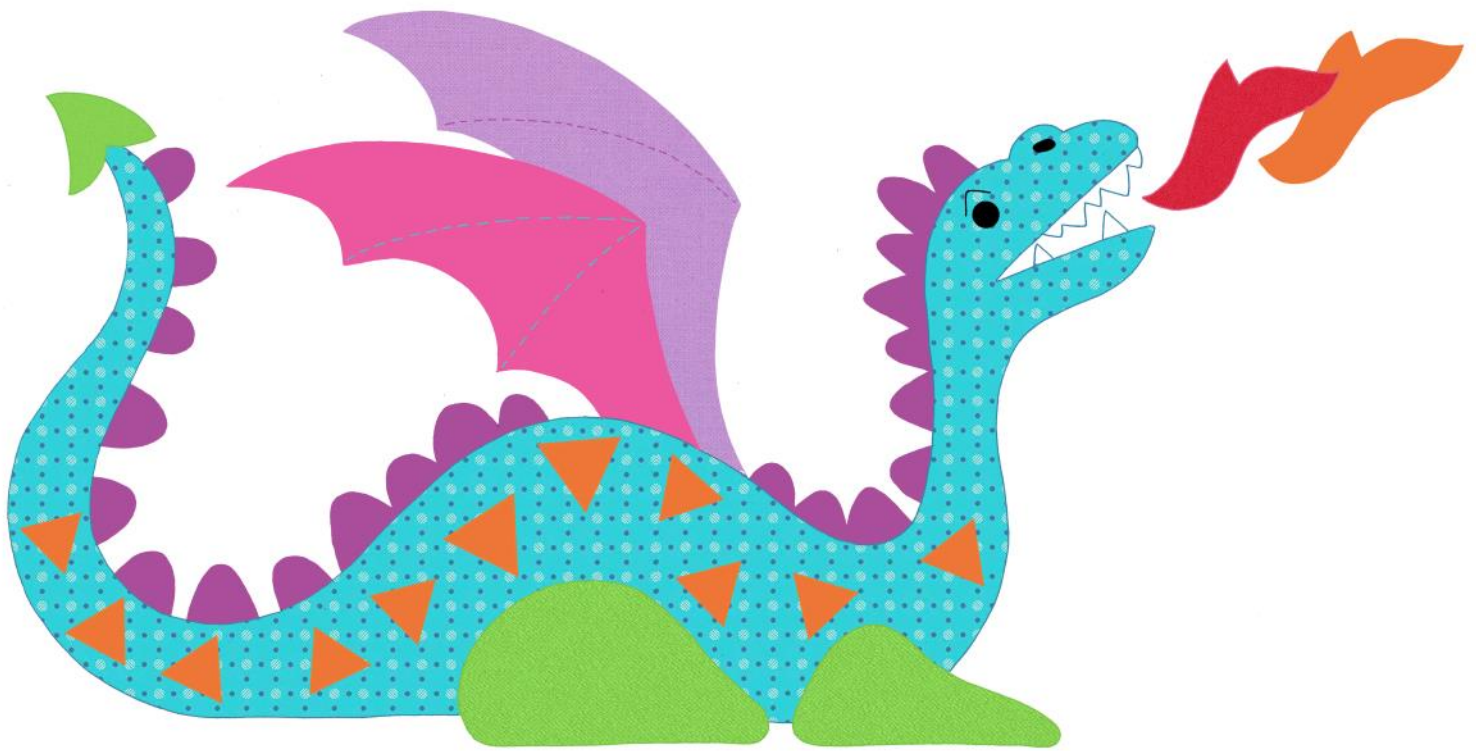


FAIRYTALE SEW-ALONG

BLOCK #8

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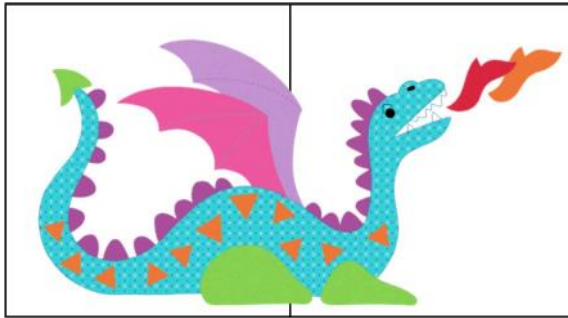
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Notes!

1. Use Diagram 1 as a guide to pin and then sew (2) background blocks together along the long edges. Press the seams open—this allows any overlapping applique to sit as flat as possible.

Fuse the dragon in place in the same manner as before, ensuring it sits approx. 3/8in above the bottom raw edge of the block.

Further Notes!

- ★ Take your time putting the dragon together, it's easy but those spikes and teeth can be fiddly and move about. I highly recommend the use of an applique sheet when fusing the dragon together.

- ★ I have trimmed my blocks from the original 10 1/2in x 12 1/2in to measure 10 1/2in x 11 1/2in. I added the extra inch to the height of the original blocks to allow for applique shrinkage.

My background fabric isn't shrinking at all this time around, it's a very tight weave, therefore I have extra fabric at the top of the blocks.

I leave this decision up to you, it won't make a difference to the finished quilt except for a few inches in length. Message me if you are unsure!

FAIRYTALE SEW-ALONG—BLOCK #8

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- Backstitch the wing detail where marked in grey.
- Tip! Fuse the wings together as a separate piece to begin.

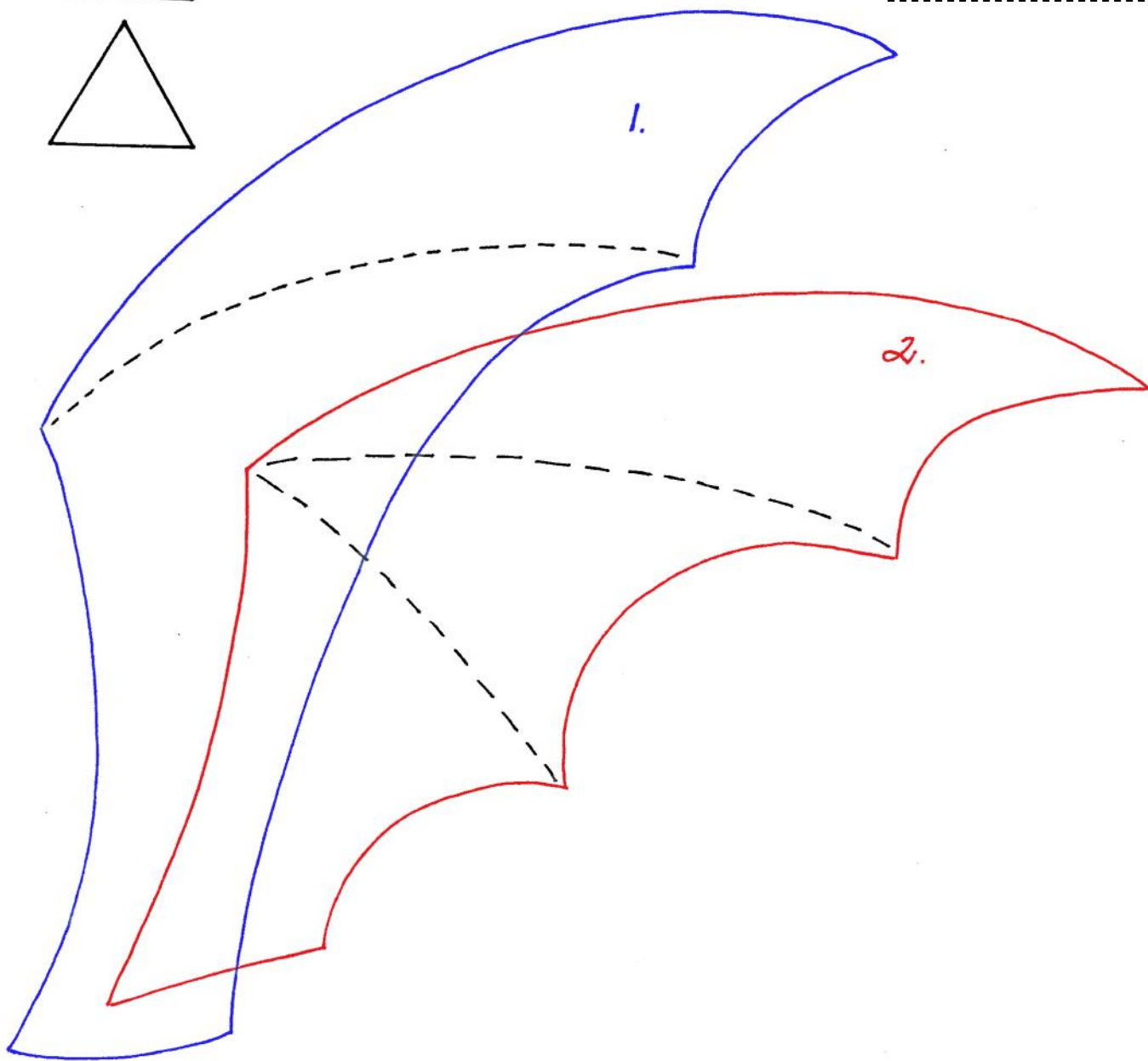
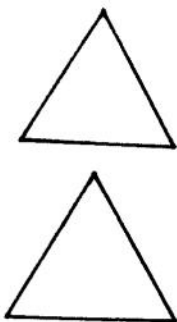
Ensure you leave approx. 3/8in between the appliqué shapes and the side and top edges of the blocks or rows. This will prevent the appliqué from being sewn into the seams.

Notes!

The numbers represent the order in which the appliqué shapes are fused together.

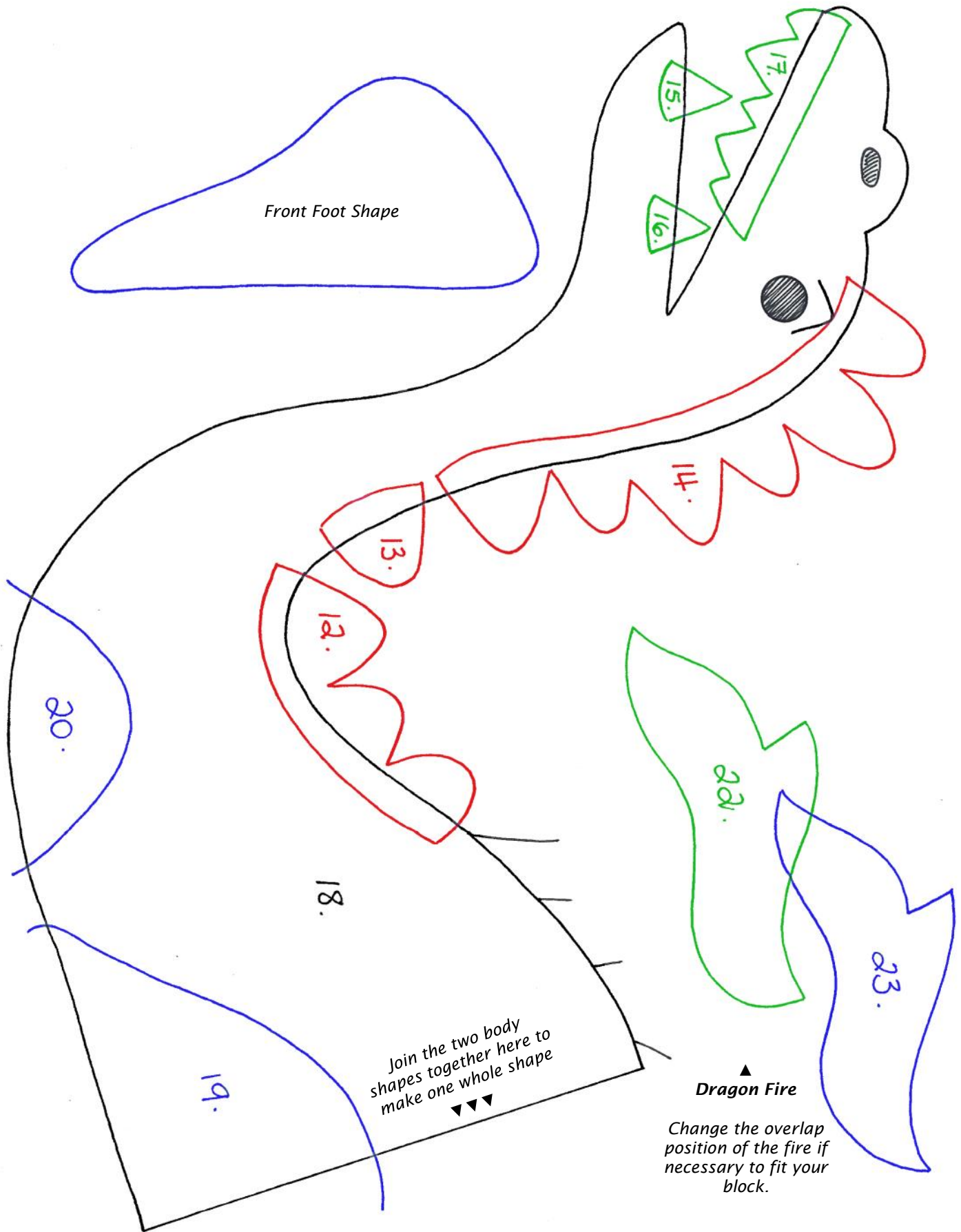
◀ Dragon Spots

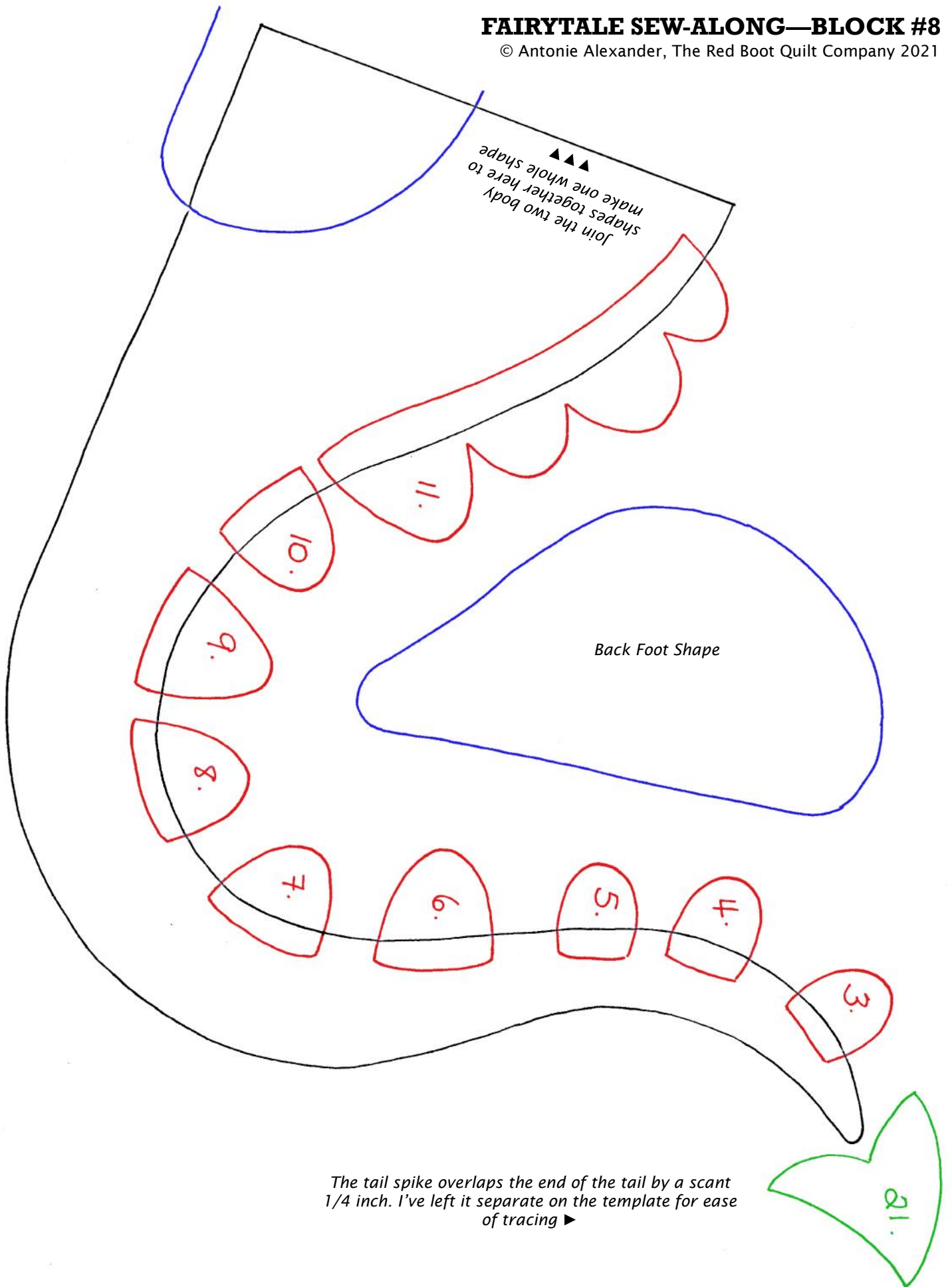
Join the two body shapes together here to make one whole shape
